- The PDF file of your online registering signed (with university stamp) by a representative of your home university (the registering file with all the documents must be sent by email in one pdf file)
- Your learning agreement completed with the courses of Sciences Po Strasbourg *
- All transcripts since your first year of graduate studies
- A copy of your passport or identity card
- One photo (JPEG only)
- Copy of your European social security card valid for the duration of the exchange (for Erasmus students) *
- Copy of the RAMQ for students of Quebec
- 1 certification of your level in French (certificate on honour accepted)
- 1 certification of your level [in English](#) (minimum B2) ; not required for native English-speakers or applicants who have studied at university in an English-speaking country
- Personal statement of interest in the programme
- C.V. with ID picture

Students are responsible for undertaking the French visa process *as soon as possible* so that they can begin on the official CES start date.
